The Sedibeng District Municipality seeks to appoint a suitably qualified security service provider, to provide guarding security services and Security management Services. The successful bidder will enter into one (1) year contract with an option to renew for another 2 years based on performance and budget availability.

Sedibeng District Municipality has a total number of 14 Sites as per deployment plan of sites that are spread across the district, the proposal is at least deploy 36 security officers to ensure maximum security is in place, unless the prospective bidder has any proposal number to render the expected services as per the required deliverables and sites, we will accept any proposal that will save Municipality funds.
